Burlingame Ranch Affordable Housing

ASLA Award of Honor in Analysis and Planning 2005

DHM's involvement in the Burlingame Ranch project began at the inception of the community planning (COWOP) process in 2000. Since that time, DHM has participated directly in the programming & master planning of the entire site, as well as design and construction documentation of Phase I of the project. The design team asserted that livability was a vital component in the aggressive sustainability program of the project. The site plan is focused on creating several smaller neighborhoods within a larger community in an effort to foster neighbor-to-neighbor interactions and provide a high quality of life.

Aspen Valley Hospital Master Plan

DHM is currently working with a team of architects, engineers, and planners to create and implement a long-range master facilities plan for the local hospital. The hospital improvements will bring the facility up to current standards of care in the hospital industry, while maintaining uninterrupted services throughout the process. DHM's scope includes public/entitlement process, site planning & landscape architecture, and planning support. The hospital intends to seek LEED certification for the second phase of the building expansion, slated for completion in 2013.

Lift One Neighborhood Master Plan COWOP

This project encompasses approximately 8 acres at the base of Aspen mountain which includes the original Lift. It is a Public/Private partnership between the City of Aspen, the Aspen Ski Company and two hotel developments. DHM provided planning, design and graphic support to a 27 person citizen's committee throughout a six month public process (COWOP); participating in weekly meetings, design charrettes, and presentations. DHM generated products based on direction given by the COWOP group, producing site plan studies, graphic visualizations and submittal documents for the agreed upon plan.

Carbondale Recreation Center

Located one block from the commercial core and adjacent to the regional trail system, the landscape around the Town Rec Center building, Town Hall, and parking lot has been transformed into a community garden demonstrating irrigation specific landscape zones and stormwater management. Signage describing the different systems and plant communities reinforce the educational component of the garden. DHM provided site plans & details, garden design, GOCO grant assistance, and LEED point assistance. The project achieved LEED Platinum Certification in January of 2009.



Since joining DHM in 2000, Jason has been involved in a broad range of projects, including hospital campus planning, community centers and parks, single family residential design, neighborhood master plans, and affordable housing projects. Jason has been directly involved in numerous LEED Certified and sustainably focused projects in the region. He believes that the components of environmental stewardship, functionality and human comfort are inextricable from the design process and the ultimate, lasting quality of a built project.
