##### Johnson Habitat Park | Denver, CO

Johnson Habitat Park is being transformed with educational, ecological and habitat improvements, through wetland creation, native plant establishment, streambank restoration and recreational improvements. Improved river access and visibility was achieved by opening the floodplain and riverbank, regrading the steep slopes and embankments and creating formal access to the river through ADA concrete trails and sculpted concrete jetties. Recreation opportunities were integrated through an improved and updated regional trail section, educational interactive natural play elements, a firepit, and traditional play equipment outside of the floodplain. The site features are specially designed to support environmental educational activities.

##### Sand Creek Trail | Denver, CO

Mark assisted with master plan development that looked at trail alignment alternatives, right-of-way and easement acquisition, implementation strategies. This work continued with the development of the master plan into conceptual designs and construction documents. The Sand Creek Trail corridor is over 6 miles in length.

##### Lyons Parks Flood Recovery Planning

Mark was the Principal-in-Charge of the design team that completed a series of 9 public meetings for the Town of Lyons parks and trails that were affected by the 2013 floods. Our team evaluated the extent of the flood damage in relation to pre-flood conditions, including FEMA damage assessment documents, and conducted a robust public engagement process that allowed for the entire community to get involved with flood recovery planning of their parks. The public process was extensive and often sensitive, garnering more comments on a DHM managed project web site than any other we have maintained. In the end, community support for the master plans was attained and
