Community Planning

Community planning & design experience includes large-scale master planning projects, mixed-use and urban environments. He brings a unique perspective to neighborhood design having been a custom home builder in both Prospect New Town and Bradburn Village, both of which are successful new-urbanism communities in Colorado. A favorite project of Marc's is a unique neighborhood in Karuizawa, Japan developed by Kajima Corp. that required his careful attention to the placement of roads, home sites, trails and community garden spaces into a pristine wooded area on hilly topography. The result is a well-crafted, secluded retreat where the buildings, roads and site walls appropriately fade into the background of the forest.

Parks & Campuses

Marc says his best insight on park design comes from his kids. Observing how people use and enjoy public spaces has influenced his work on projects such as Stapleton parks and open space, Westminster City Park, Chapungu African Sculpture Park in Loveland, Colorado and Mushrif Central Park in Abu Dhabi, U.A.E. Corporate and education campus projects include Reebok World Headquarters in Canton, MA, The Washington State Government Campus in Olympia, and Islandwood – a 255-acre outdoor learning center for kids on Bainbridge Island, WA.
