NOTABLE WORK

Cape Canaveral National Cemetery

The Cape Canaveral National Cemetery is a new facility designed to serve veterans throughout the Central Florida area. The program includes 7 phases of development, providing almost 167,000 burial sites at completion. Burial options include traditional in-ground crypts, columbarium crypts, ossuaries and memorial walls. In addition to the burial sites, the cemetery also includes a public information center, an administration building, a ceremonial assembly area, a maintenance facility, five committal shelters for services, six columbaria plazas, a memorial wall and a memorial walk. Design services included site planning, concept development, phasing development, cost estimating, landscape design, irrigation design, lighting design, presentations to the national design review team and construction documentation.

BahaMar Resort & Golf Course

Baha Mar is a new destination resort in Nassau, Bahamas. Upon completion it will boast 2,200 sleeping rooms split between 4 hotels, a grand casino, convention center, gardens, a marine wildlife sanctuary, 3,300 LF of beach and a private golf course. Work was completed on an 18-hole Jack Nicklaus Signature Golf Course and clubhouse in early 2015. The site plan, planting plan and hardscape design for the golf clubhouse were developed to maximize site views to the new resort and the golf course, while incorporating inventive reuse of historic structures located on the site such as utilizing the base structure of an existing water tank and converting it into an elevated dining and event space. Additional design services were provided for the roadways, project entries, beach improvements, canal shopping district, convention center and hotel entries.
