Glenwood Hot Springs hired DHM Design and Cloward H2O to design aquatic elements that would provide enhanced activities for children and families, honor the history of the site and European Spa character, and re-energize the 130+ year old facility. The chosen design includes an interactive fountain that is a splash-pad for all ages by day and a show fountain at night; a zero-entry toddler pool with interactive spouts and nozzles; a kid's pool with a waterfall, play area and three water slides; and an adventure river that is integrated into the slope of the hillside and simulates the thrill of tubing down a whitewater river. Each element was designed to elevate the visitor experience while respecting the resort's contextual and cultural history.

The Basalt River Restoration was a collaborative and comprehensive approach to achieving a number of long-standing social, environmental, economic and community goals for the Town of Basalt including public access to the river, a riverfront park, redefinition of the floodplain and the transformation of a prominent downtown corner location. DHM shepherded the site planning effort and was involved in all aspects of the process from community meetings and design to coordination with engineers and federal agencies for proposed restoration improvements.

Riverside Residence | Aspen, CO

Thoughtful planning and design were required to enhance a home in a sensitive environment along the banks of the Roaring Fork River. Decisions for the site complemented the architecture and setting with a landscape that transitions from a highly detailed contemporary garden down to a restored native riparian environment along the riverfront. As avid collectors of art, and unique natural history and historical objects, the owners wanted pieces of their collection to be thoughtfully integrated into the design of the landscape. Outdoor living space was a key element of the design, including patio and garden spaces, an outdoor kitchen, and a custom fire feature that overlooks the river. Large, flexible spaces off the living room and master bedroom include a spa, cabana lounge area and patios to accommodate small or large gatherings.
