Three Springs | Durango, CO

CCASLA Merit Award 2007

DHM Design developed a landscape masterplan as a framework for tying the Three Springs community together. As part of that effort, parks, trails, plazas, wetlands, monumentation, signage, and wayfinding elements were designed and implemented. DHM Design completed the design for the streetscape in the village core of Three Springs. The design incorporates recycled and reclaimed materials into the furnishings. Generous pedestrian spaces were set up along the storefronts with a number of outdoor cafes. Planter beds, pots, and raised boxes with xeric plantings were incorporated to add color and texture to the streetscape. A raised, free-flow pedestrian intersection and concrete crosswalks were used to enhance the pedestrian experience. With all of these elements in place, we are creating a healthy, vibrant, safe and walkable community at Three Springs.

Ouray Hot Springs | Ouray, CO

Referred to as the "Switzerland of America," and situated in the San Juan Mountains of Southwest Colorado, Ouray is a true gem of the Rocky Mountain Region. The concept for the hot springs was to create a more natural atmosphere that blends with the mountain surroundings, while also respecting and paying tribute to the historic oval form of the pool. One of the biggest improvements is the expansive curved designed pool with the white bottom for a refreshing ambiance. The hot/soaking pools now have capacity for more people and the space feels more intimate. The new deck space separates the pools for different uses and improves the pool's functionality and ease of maintenance. New features include a lap pool, LED water lights to replace bright over-hanging lights, local boulders in the pool edges and deck space, shade sails, ADA accessibility and slides.

Zion National Park | Springdale, UT

DHM is working with the National Park Service to plan improvements for the congested south entrance to Zion National Park. New fee stations, relocated entry monument, improved pedestrian connections and expanded parking and wayfinding have been planned, with some elements already implemented. At the Visitor Center, the plaza is extended out through the parking area to create pedestrian spines to help guide visitors to the main building. DHM has also been involved with the latest phases of design for the newly constructed Watchman Campground improvements and redesign of the Zion Shuttle Transit Stop, Weeping Rock and Emerald Pools parking areas.
